Blue Mountain College were entered in the Milo Shield Cricket in Term 1.

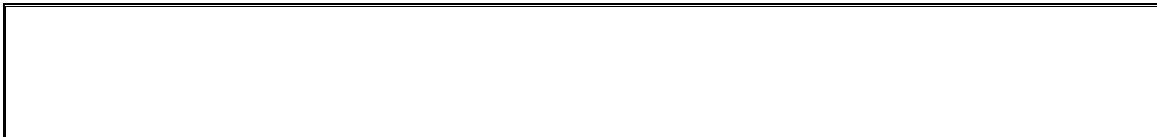
